With referece to above, the Vice-Chancellor is pleased to order that the following concessions to be implemented for <u>Hearing Impaired</u>, <u>Orthopedically handicapped and Visually challenged students</u> studying Undergraduate (BA/B.Com/B.Sc etc.), Post graduate (M.A/M.Com, M.Sc etc.) and Professional Courses (MBA/MCA/Engineering/Pharmacy etc.) studying in the University and its affiliated colleges.

- 1. Exemption from payments of Examination fee.
- 2. Reduction of Pass marks in each subject by 10%
- 3. 30 minutes extra time to write the university examination papers for Visually Challenged students and Orthopedically handicapped students, who cannot use their hands freely for writing and have to necessarily use a scribe.
